

# Information: Class Overview + Subject Choices

We request that you submit your subject choices for the up and coming school year at Ranum Efterskole College. In order to do this, you should follow the link sent to you via e-mail to our online form. Here you will submit your name and student number, before answering a series of multiple-choice questions that will provide us with the information that we need. This information should be submitted by the 20<sup>th</sup> March. It is important that you are registered and enrolled within the correct class and curriculum, for example 9<sup>th</sup> grade international (9IG) or 9<sup>th</sup> grade Danish (9X). We need your subject choices in order to build your schedule for next year, and so that we can ensure the correct resources are available to all students. Your subject choices are in that respect, for us to build the framework for teaching during the coming year. The choices that you make before starting in August are not binding, and should you change your mind before the school year begins you can contact us via the above mail to make amendments. It may also occur that after you have begun your year at Ranum Efterskole College you have a change of heart with regards to a subject or the class you have chosen. Rest assured that it is possible to make changes after the school year starts, and we will handle this in close dialogue with both the parents of the student in question and our guidance councillors. Regardless of which class you enrol in, teaching will occur at different levels. This is to ensure that you are always taught at a level suitable to your academic abilities.

Ranum Efterskole College runs both the Danish curriculum as well as the international curriculum. Within these two groups, there are further options based on age and academic level.

- Der undervises 30 lektioner pr. uge i boglige fag og 10 timer pr. uge i valgfag og profilfag.
- Der laves projektopgave i løbet af skoleår.
- Skoleåret afsluttes med FP9, folkeskolens afgangsprøve 9. årgang.
- 9X må også gerne vælge English på international niveau, hvor de afslutter året med både FP9 afgangsprøve og Cambridge examen.

- Der undervises på dansk i alle obligatoriske fag og vi følger målene for den danske folkeskole.
- Boglige fag: Dansk, engelsk, matematik, idræt + 3 valgfrie 10. klasses fag.
- Der undervises 30 lektioner pr. uge i boglige fag og valgfag og op til 10 timer pr. uge i aktivitetsfag og profilfag.
- Der laves OSO, og eleven er på brobygning i 5 dage.
- Skoleåret afsluttes med FP10 i dansk, engelsk og matematik. Det er også muligt at afslutte Tysk, Fransk og Fysik/Kemi med folkeskolens 10. klasses afgangsprøve.
- 10+ må også gerne vælge English samt flere IGCSE fag i valgruppe to og valgruppe tre på international niveau, hvor de afslutter året med både FP10 afgangsprøve i engelsk og de relevante Cambridge prøver.

9. IGCSE
Dansk English Maths/Matematik Science/Naturfag Global Perspectives German Idræt

### 9<sup>th</sup> Grade International Class (9 IGCSE)

9 IGCSE is a preparatory course for the Danish Gymnasium that shares targets also appropriate for further study within Danish X-educational programs. It also opens up possibilities for further study within international programs such as the IB and A-level.

- Teaching will be in English, and students will study between 3 and 5 international Cambridge IGCSEs alongside Danish at the appropriate level sanctioned by the Danish folkeskole.
- Subjects: Danish, English, Maths, Science, Languages, Global Perspectives and Idræt.
- Teaching is divided over 30 modules per week, as well as up to 10 hours of extracurricular subjects.
- The classes are taught in such a way that the subject aims set by the Danish folkeskole curriculum are covered.
- There will be a compulsory project assignment that is to be completed in Danish.
- The school year will finish with exams in the elected IGCSE subjects as well as the Danish folkeskole final examinations FP9.
- 9IG students can also choose 9IG Flex. Maths and Science are then traded out with their Danish counterparts, and you will only attend the international exams in English, Global Perspectives and German.
- There are no prerequisites for 9 IGCSE but the academic level is higher than 9X and you should be a confident English speaker with high grades in both reading and writing.

### 10<sup>th</sup> Grade International Class (10 IGCSE)

10 IGCSE is a preparatory course for the Danish Gymnasium that shares targets also appropriate for further study within Danish X-educational programs<sup>1</sup>. It also opens up possibilities for further study within international programs such as the IB and A-level.

- Teaching will be in English, and students will study 5 international Cambridge IGCSE levels alongside Danish at the appropriate level sanctioned by the Danish folkeskole.
- Subjects: Danish, English, Maths, Global Perspectives and two more subject choices.
- Teaching is divided over 30 modules per week, as well as up to 10 hours of extracurricular subjects.
- There will be an OSO assignment during the school year as well as 5 days of bridge building.
- The school year will finish with exams in elected IGCSE subjects as well as the folkeskole final examination FP10 in Danish, Maths and English.

There are no prerequisites for 10 IGCSE but the academic level is higher than 10 PLUS and you should be a confident English speaker with high grades in both reading and writing.

*\*In the event that no more than 10 students choose a subject, we may decide to not run that course. Should this happen, we will contact you and give you the chance to choose again.*

### Activity Subject (A1)

- All students must choose an Activity Subject for their first period.
- Activity subjects are activity or skill based, and happen once a week.
- The subjects are a mixture of both creative and active subjects

### Profile Subject (P1)

- All students will choose a profile subject after New Students Day, where there will be an opportunity to hear more about the different subjects.
- Profile subjects are activity or skill based, and happen three times a week: on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.
- The subjects are a mixture of both creative and active subjects, and culminate in a trip that will allow students to put what they have learned into practice.
