- •All will be tested twice while in Norway.
- If a student test positive when entering Norway then they will have to go to a PCR to confirm that positive quick test.
- •If a student has recently had corona and can prove this, the Norwegian authorities will assess if a PCR or Isolation is needed.
- •If a student then tests positive with a PCR test then we will discuss the situation with the Norwegian authorities.
- •If Isolation is required then it will depend on their symptoms how long they are in isolation. If you have symptoms, you can end isolation when at least 6 days have passed since the time the symptoms started and you have been fever-free for at least 24 hours. This applies regardless of whether you have been vaccinated or not. If you have no symptoms, you can end isolation when 6 days have passed since you took the positive covid-19 test. This applies regardless of whether you have been vaccinated or not.
- •We have hired extra accommodation in Norway for isolation if we need it, so no one goes to a government isolation hotel.
- •If a student is in Isolation then there will of course be staff looking after that student, also if the other students have returned to Denmark.
- •The cost of isolation is cover by the schools insurance.
